Archie Glen Kelly, Jr., 88, of Ider, Alabama born September 26, 1925 in West Virginia and passed from this life on July 3rd, 2014, at Home. Mr. Kelly was a U.S. Marine Purple Heart recipient for his service in the South Pacific during World War II. He was also a retired Teamster having worked for many years on the truck docks of St. Louis retiring in 1982. He was longtime member and Deacon at the New Testament Baptist Church in Cahokia, IL and most recently a member of the Pleasant Grove Baptist Church in Trenton, GA.
