Bradley Wade Teet, 53, of Chattanooga, and formerly of Lookout Mountain, passed away peacefully surrounded by friends and family on January 28, 2023. Brad was a decorated veteran who served in Iraq and had previously spent 4 years of active duty.

Brad was born on June 24, 1969, to parents Irby Teet and Deanna Atchley in Trenton, GA.

Brad graduated in 1987 from Northwest Georgia High School and always emphasized his

love for riding dirt bikes. At the young age of four, Brad received his first bike and it was love

at first sight. If he wasn't riding a bike, he was fixing one up. His love for mechanics

translated later into his military career, where he became a diesel mechanic for the Army.

Brad would go on to serve for two tours, one being right out of high school and one after the events of 9/11.

When he wasn't working on bikes, he was working hard at being the best father to his two

girls. He loved them endlessly and always wanted what was best for them. He was goofy

and a big joker with his family and friends, always a cut-up who constantly made people laugh and smile. Anyone who knew Brad knows that although he was stubborn as a mule, he was a fierce and loyal friend, he was always willing to give a helping hand.
