



## Cordia Pallie Cooper

July 8, 1928 - December 27, 2014

Cordia Pallie Gossett Cooper, age 86, of Rising Fawn, GA died on Saturday, December 27, 2014. Pallie was the beloved wife of Jeril R. Cooper, Jr., and mother of Jerry, O.P. and Crystal Dawn Cooper. A faithful member of the Rising Fawn United Methodist Church, Pallie especially enjoyed singing in the choir.
