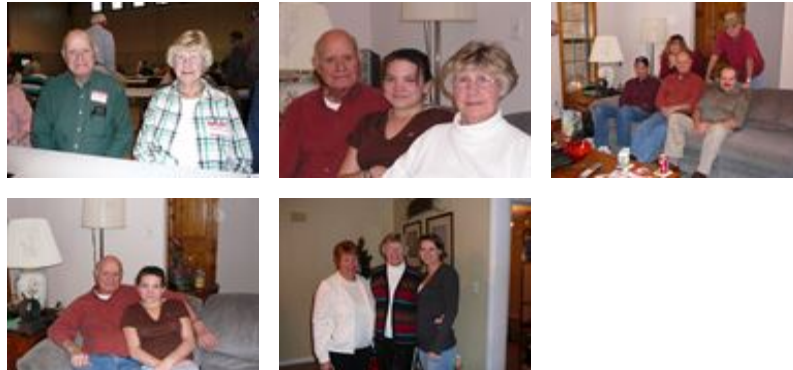
“ Aunt Hilda and Boland family,
