Donald Edward Street, age 90, of Wildwood, GA died on Friday, February 20, 2015 at Dade Health and Rehab. Don was born in Wildwood, GA on February 23, 1924. For many years he owned and operated Street Hardware in Trenton and was also a wholesale hardware salesman in the tri-state area. He was a World War II veteran serving in the Naval Armed Guard making at least twelve trips across the Atlantic to deliver soldiers and supplies and return with the wounded. He was a Boy Scout Leader and for many years and was a lay minister in the United Methodist Church. He was a member of Wildwood United Methodist. He loved studying his Bible, listening to gospel music, hunting, and was constantly in motion working on some project.

Donald was preceded in death by his parents, Martin B. and Jessie Moore Street, brother, Buford B. Street and sister, Eloise Smith Hawthorne.

Survivors include his wife of 66 years, Elizabeth Wallen Street and four children, Donna M.
