June 7, 1943 - February 21, 2020

Henry Luther Brooks, age 76, of Flat Rock, AL, died at his residence Friday morning, 21 February 2020. He was employed by the City of Chattanooga as Director of City Services until his retirement in 2000. As a member of Trenton United Methodist Church, he was a member of several committees and had worked as a youth leader.

Henry was also a member of Valley Hunting Club of Paint Rock, AL, and an avid fisherman. As a volunteer, he supported SpiritHorse Freedom Ranch, where he taught special-needs children archery, horseback riding, swimming, and fishing.

He was preceded in death by his parents Elbert Luther Brooks and Helen Virginia Harris Brooks. Survivors are his wife of 55 years, Lucy Brooks; his daughter, Michelle (Clinton) Dalton of Fort Payne, AL; his sons, Doug Brooks of Charlotte, NC, and Mark Brooks of Flat Rock, AL; his granddaughters, Shelby (Jeremi) Harleston, Landen Brooks, and Ansley Brooks; his sister, Ginger Brown of Tunnel Hill, GA; and several nieces and nephews.
