Imogene Parson Ryan, age 94, of Wildwood, Georgia died Thursday morning March 19, 2015 at her home. She was born at home in Morganville within a mile of where she lived. She attended Dade County schools and graduated class of 1938. She was retired from the Dade County School System where she served as secretary at the Elementary and High School. She also served as the Administrative Secretary of the Dade County Teachers Credit Union from its inception until her retirement and took pride in that she balanced with the State of Georgia on every Audit. She was a founding member of the North Dade Community Development Corp., a lifetime member of the Georgia Retired Education Association and American Business Women's Association.
