Leslie "Les" Ferrell Parker, age 82, of Lookout Mountain, GA, the West Brow Community, was born in Atlanta, GA on November 19, 1941 and passed away early Saturday February 3, 2024 surrounded by his family. He was of the Free Holiness Faith.

He met his future wife Jane Parker, which he married in 1961, in homeroom and later graduated from Chamblee High School class of 1960. Mr. Parker was a veteran of the US Air Force serving from 1961 until 1964. After leaving the Air Force, he moved to Albany, GA where he was employed by Beneficial Finance from 1968 until 1977, later joining CSX Railroad from 1977 until his retirement in 1988.
