



Louise Evans Wright Fannin

March 31, 1920 - November 23, 2014

Louise Evans Wright Fannin, age 94, of Trenton, GA died on Sunday November 23, 2014. Born in Chatsworth, GA, she was a longtime resident and community leader in Trenton, GA. She was a member of the Trenton United Methodist Church, where she taught Adult Sunday School for many years. Louise was a World War II veteran, she was one of the first female service members to enter the European Theater serving as one of Dwight D. Eisenhower's secretaries, among other assignments. Louise was the owner of Wright's Restaurant, retired from the Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Service and served as the City Recorder for the City of Trenton. Louise was preceded in death, most recently by her husband, Walter Leon Fannin. She is survived by two sisters, Geneva (Bill) Bryson of Chatsworth, GA and Evelyn (Luther) Whitaker of Chattanooga, TN. She is also survived by several nieces and nephews, great nieces and nephews and great-great nieces and nephews.
