Bonnie Lucille Price, 96, of East Ridge, TN went to her heavenly home on Wednesday November 12, 2014. A native of Rising Fawn, Georgia she is preceded in death by her husband, James A Price Jr., parents Glenn and Bonnie Hatfield; two brothers James G. Hatfield and Grover Long. She is survived by her sisters Sarah Delzell, Ina (Polly) Santos, Ann Moley, and Barbara Holland; Sister-in-law Patricia Hatfield; Stepsons, James and Ronald Price; numerous step-grandchildren; nieces and nephews. She was a veteran of the U.S. Women's Army Auxiliary Corps during World War II. Lucille and her husband enjoyed years of travel, taking them to all 50 states and 23 countries. Churches were always an essential part of her life: she spent her early years and became a Christian at Rising Fawn Baptist; was a member of First Baptist of Woodbury, N.J.; and New Hope Baptist, Englewood, FL, where she held her membership until death. For the last five years she enjoyed her Bible studies at East Ridge residence, led by Rev. Ron Perry, of South Seminole Baptist. Funeral services will be held at 1:00 p.m. on Saturday 15th of November, 2014 at Ryan Funeral Home, Trenton, GA. Family will receive friends from 11am until service time Saturday. Interment will be at Hannah Cemetery, Rising Fawn, GA, where her husband and many from her family are buried. Her life was a
