Michael "Mike" Abney, age 67, of Trenton, GA died early Sunday morning February 4, 2018. He was a Vietnam Veteran serving the U.S. Marine Corps and a member of American Legion Post 106 and founding partner of the Post 106 Honor Guard. Mr. Abney was instrumental in developing a veteran's outreach program for the incarcerated. He was a fellow Craft Mason of Trenton Lodge F&AM 179. Mike was an avid IHRA drag car racing enthusiast.

He was preceded in death by his parents G.C. and Anita Green Abney.
