



## Paul Lamar Dugan

Paul Lamar Dugan, 77, passed away October 30, 2018 after a brief illness. He was born in Rossville, GA the son of the late Harold and Lenora Dugan. He was preceded in death by brothers, Herschel and Richard Dugan and sisters Martha and Dorothy Dugan.

Paul graduated from Tennessee Wesleyan College in 1963. After graduation, he enlisted with The United States Air Force and served from 1963-1967 with most of his tour in Germany and Italy.
