Rev. William M. Hendley, age 89, of Higdon, AL formerly of Randolph County, AL died November 10, 2013. He was a Veteran of World War II, The Korean War, and his life was dedicated to his Country and to the Ministry of the Nazarene Church. Mr. Hendley was awarded 3 Bronze Stars in the Korean War, the European-African-Middle Eastern Service Medal, World War II Victory Medal, and The Purple Heart. He was retired from the United States Army.

Rev. Hendley was preceded in death by his son, Thomas Hendley, great-granddaughter, Lauren Payne.
